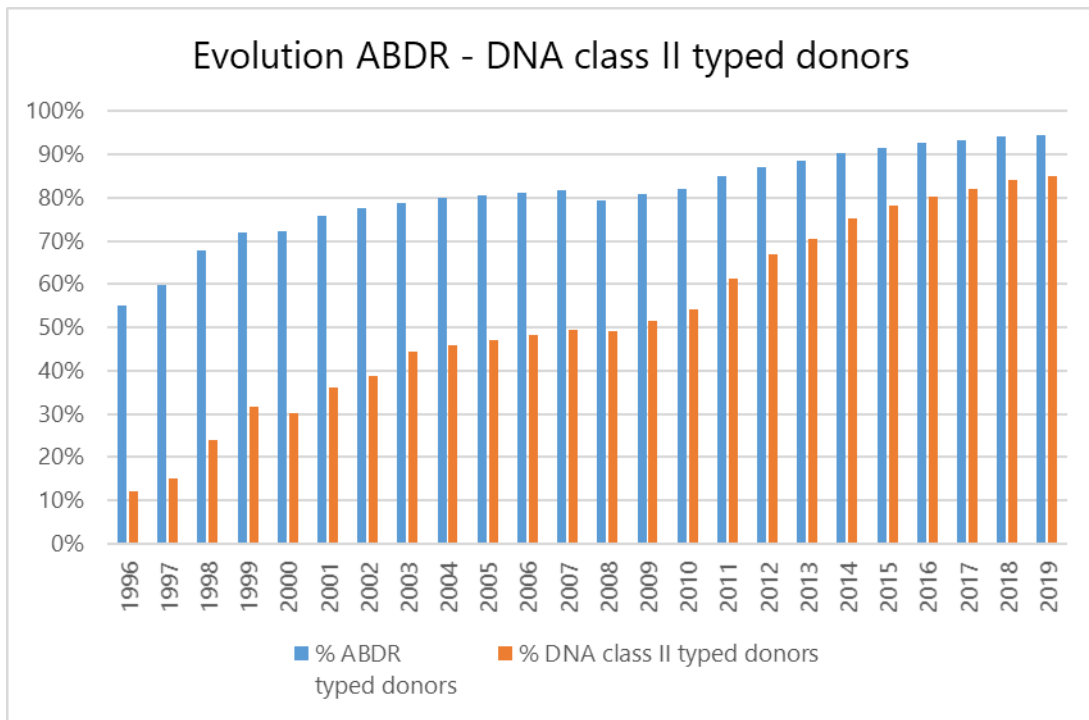

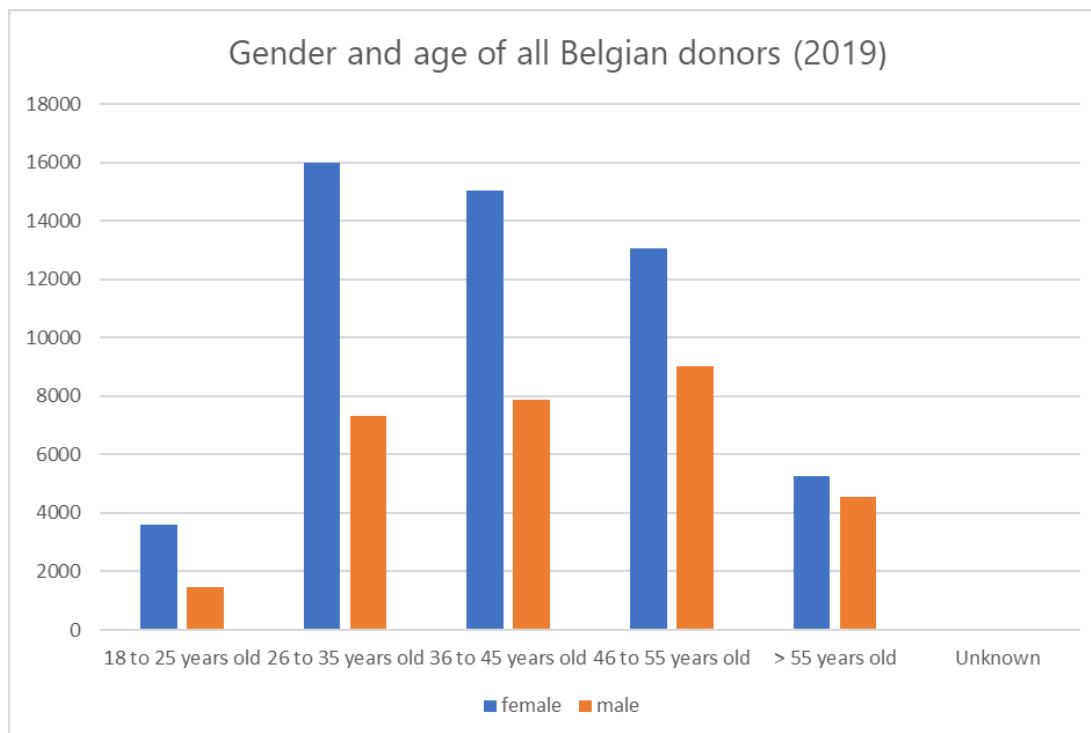

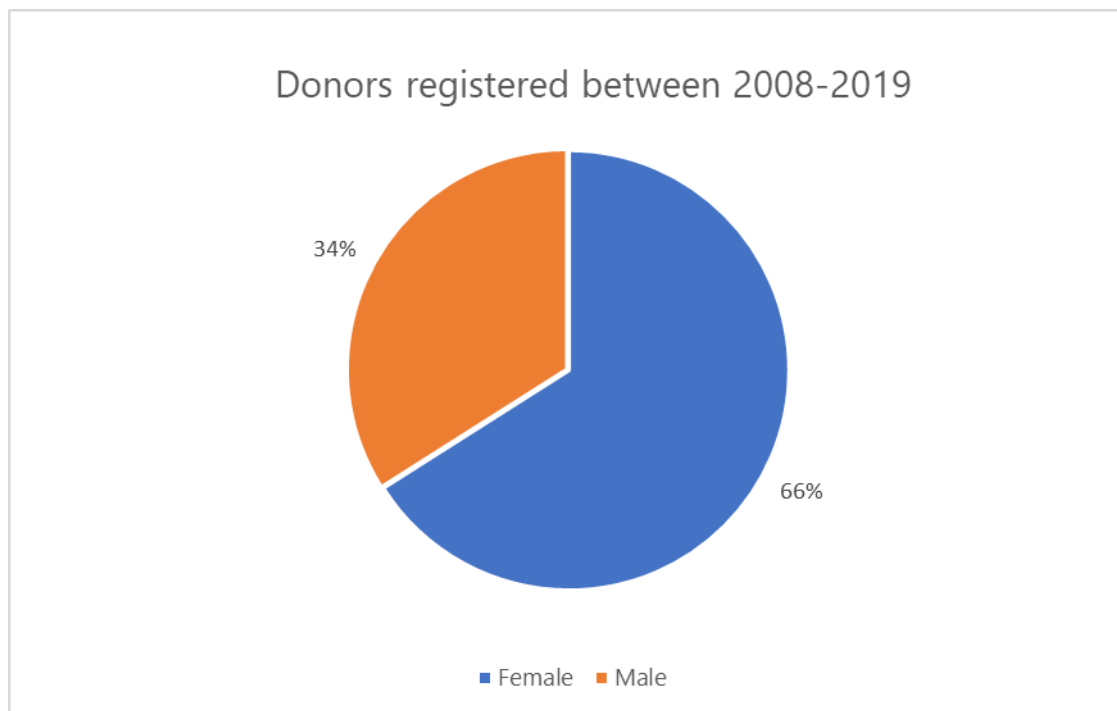

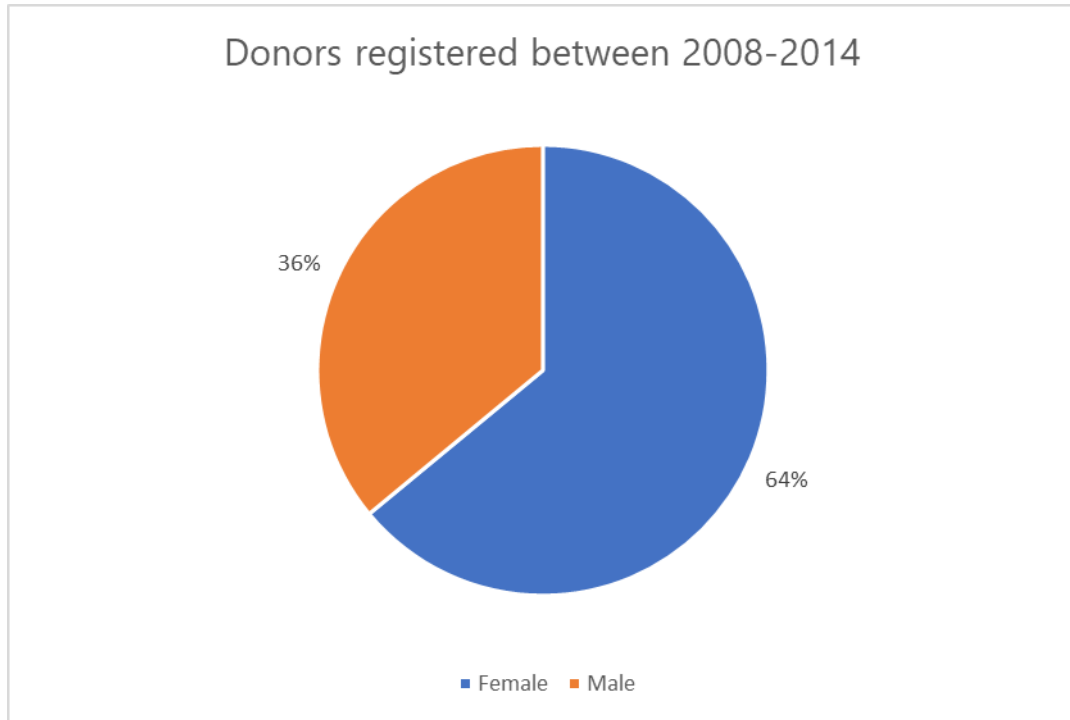

1.7.1 Ratio female – male new donors

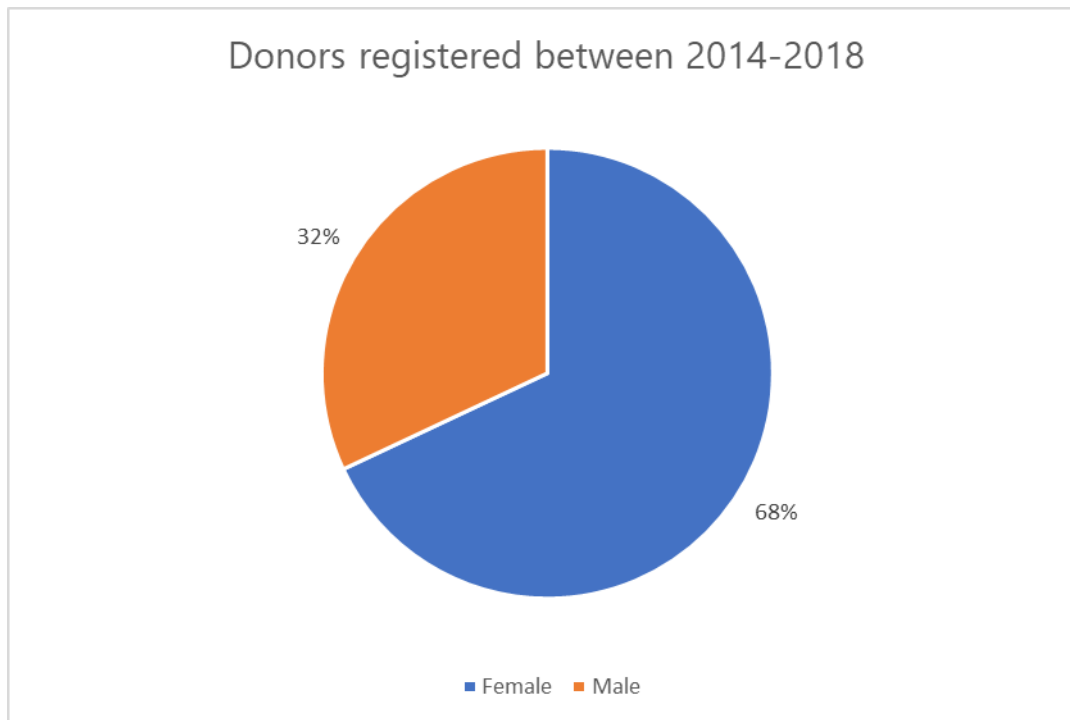
All new donors registered since 1/9/2008.



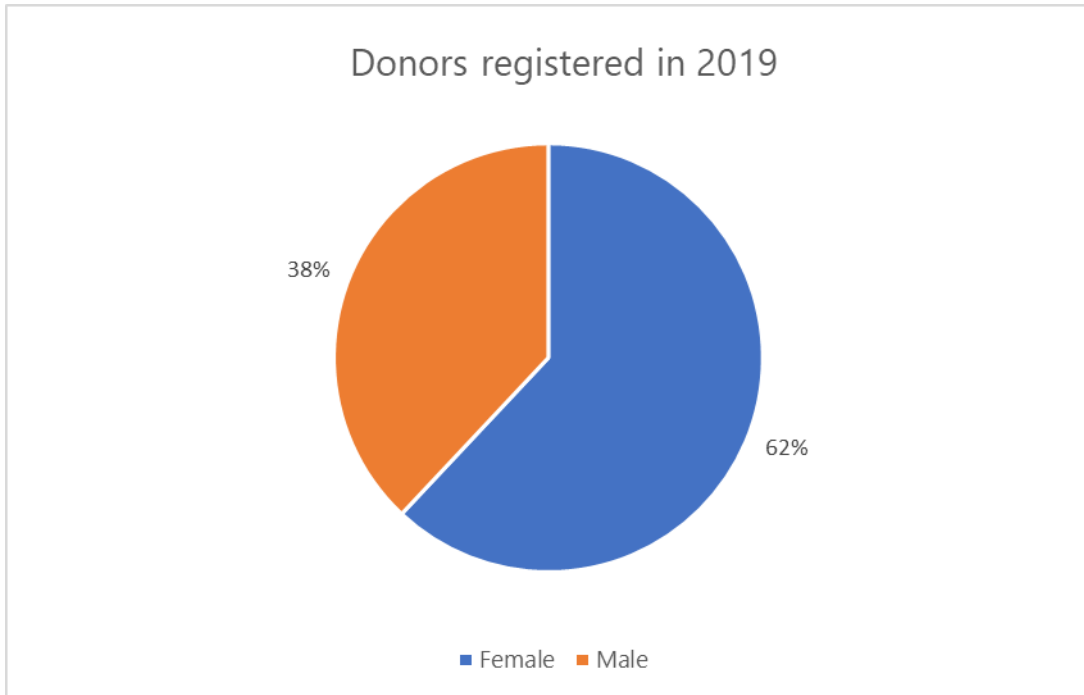
Donors registered between September 2008-August 2013 (first donor recruitment action).



Donors registered between 2014-2018 (second donor recruitment action).

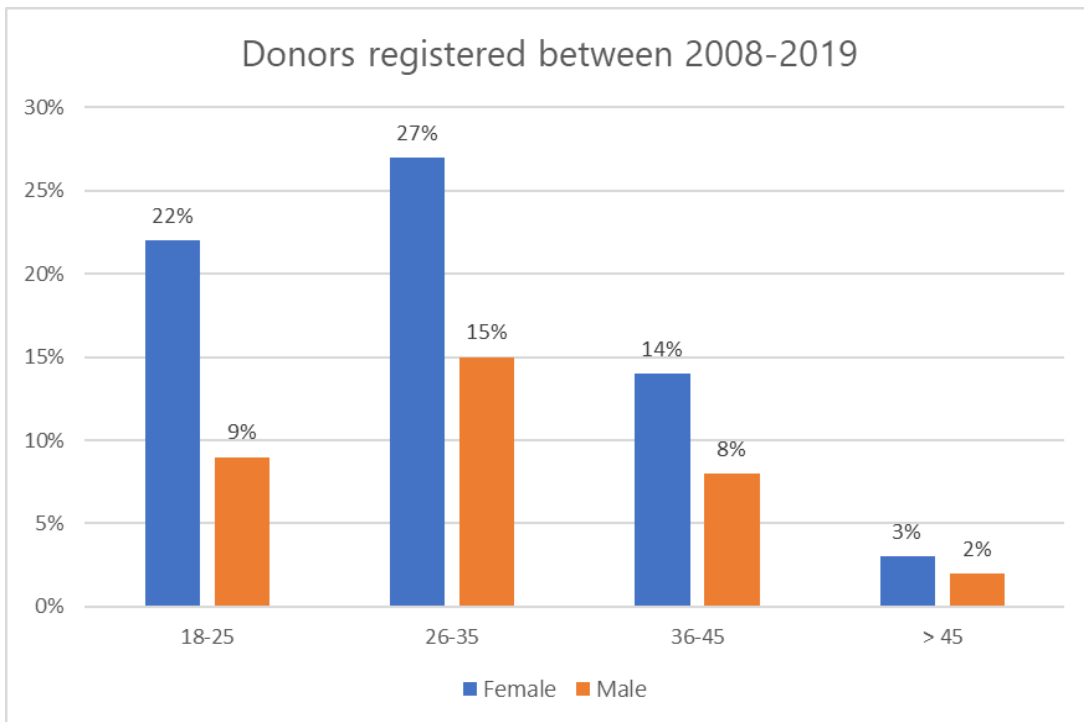


Donors registered since January 2019 (current donor recruitment action).

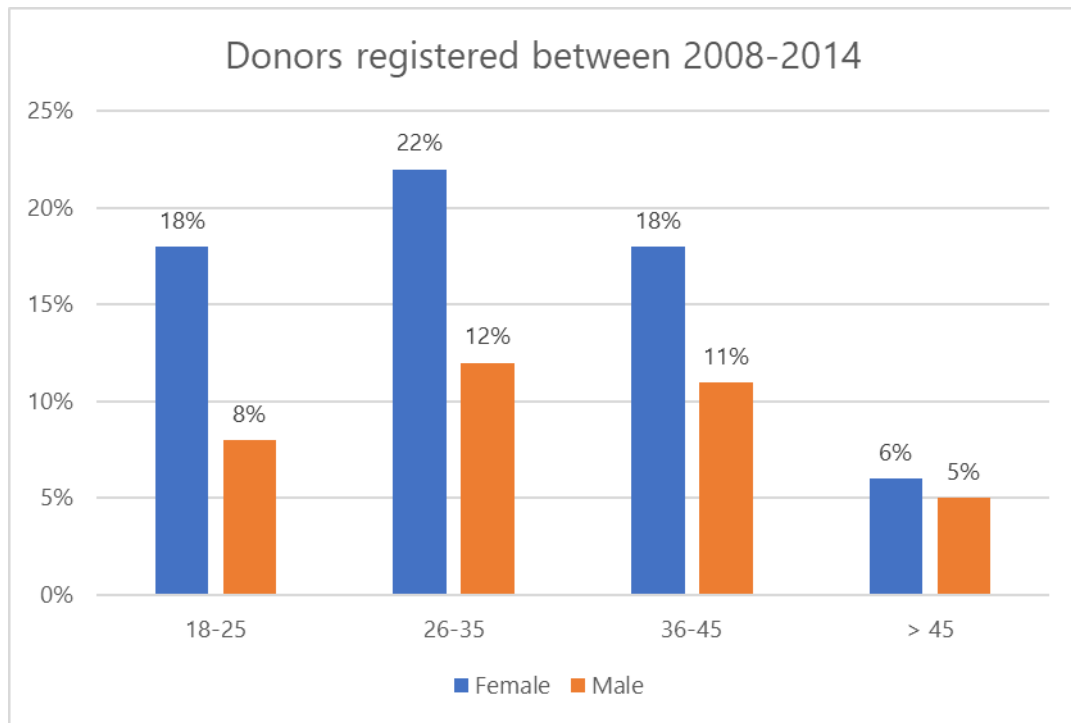

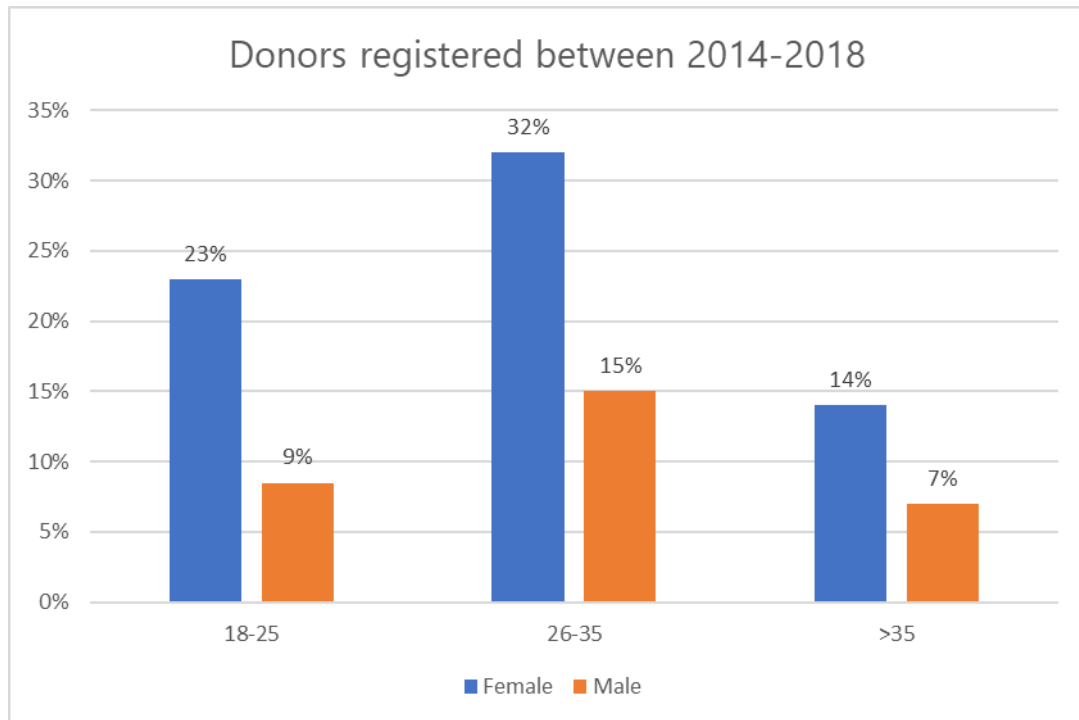
All new donors registered since 1/9/2008.



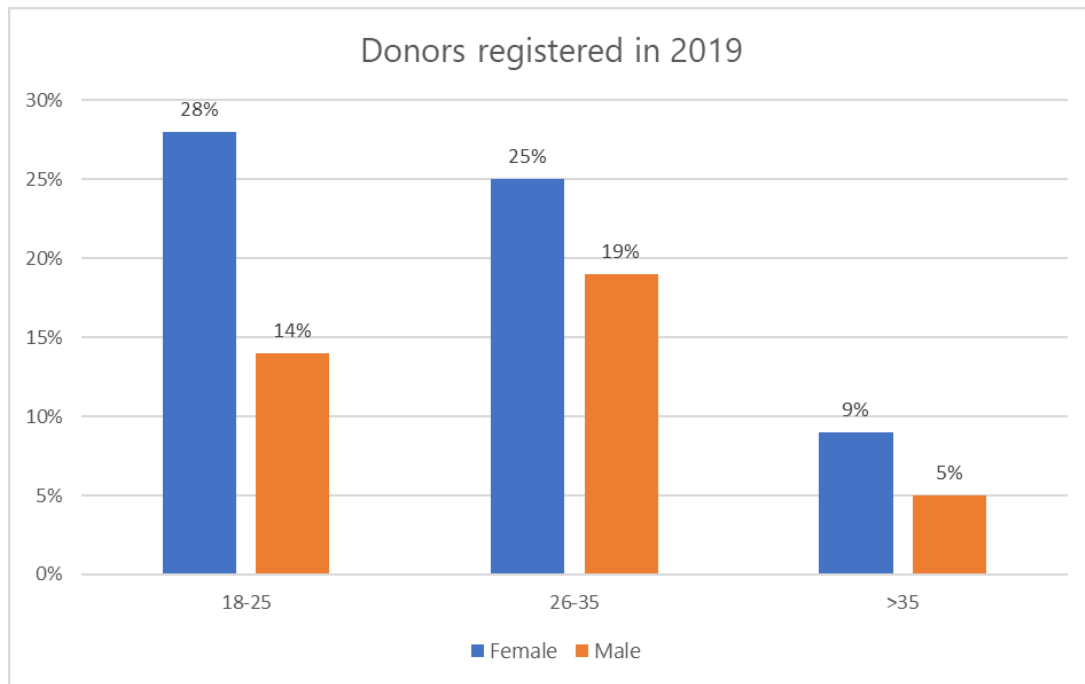
Donors registered between September 2008-August 2013 (first donor recruitment action).

Change of upper age limit of donors at registration to 40.



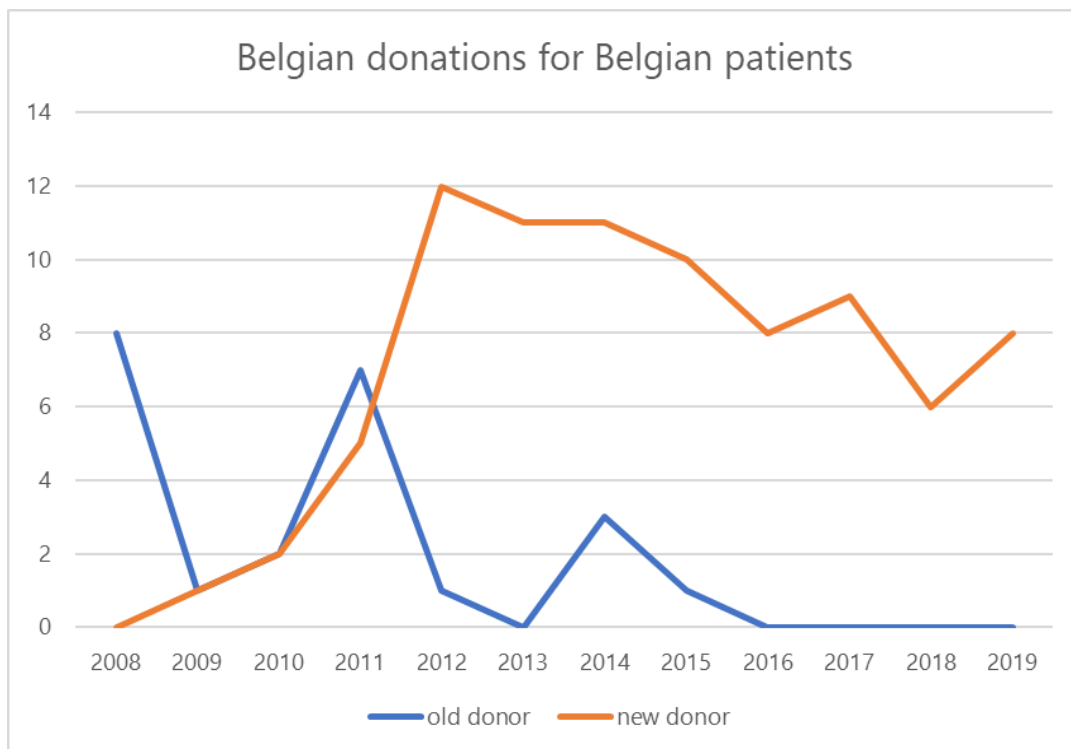

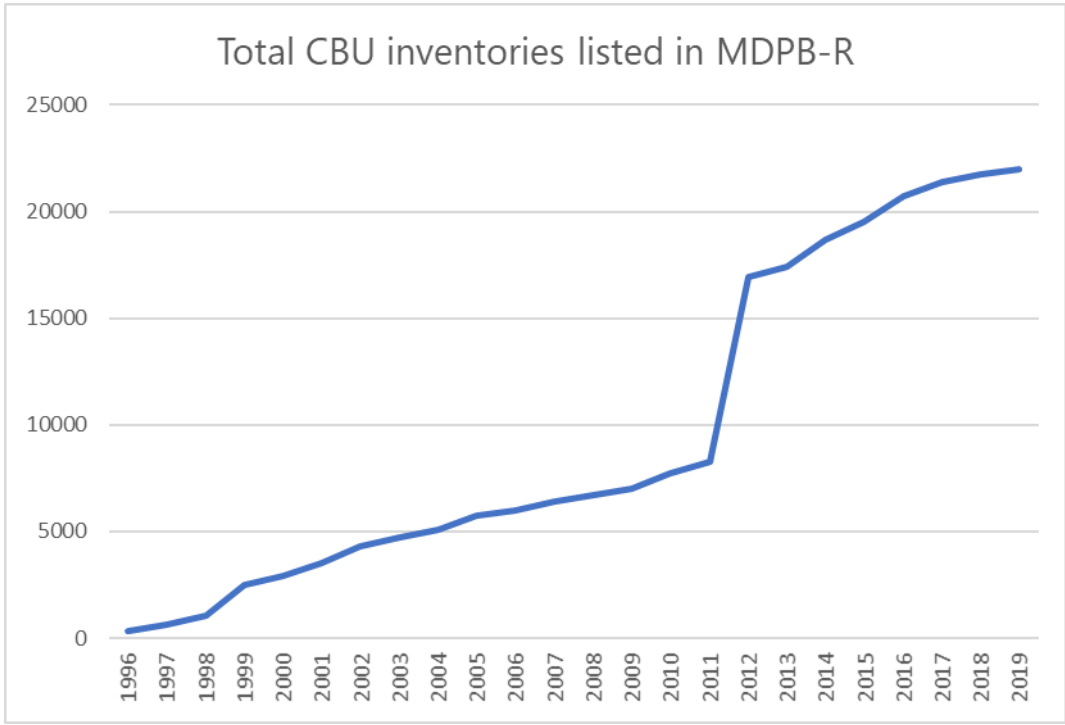

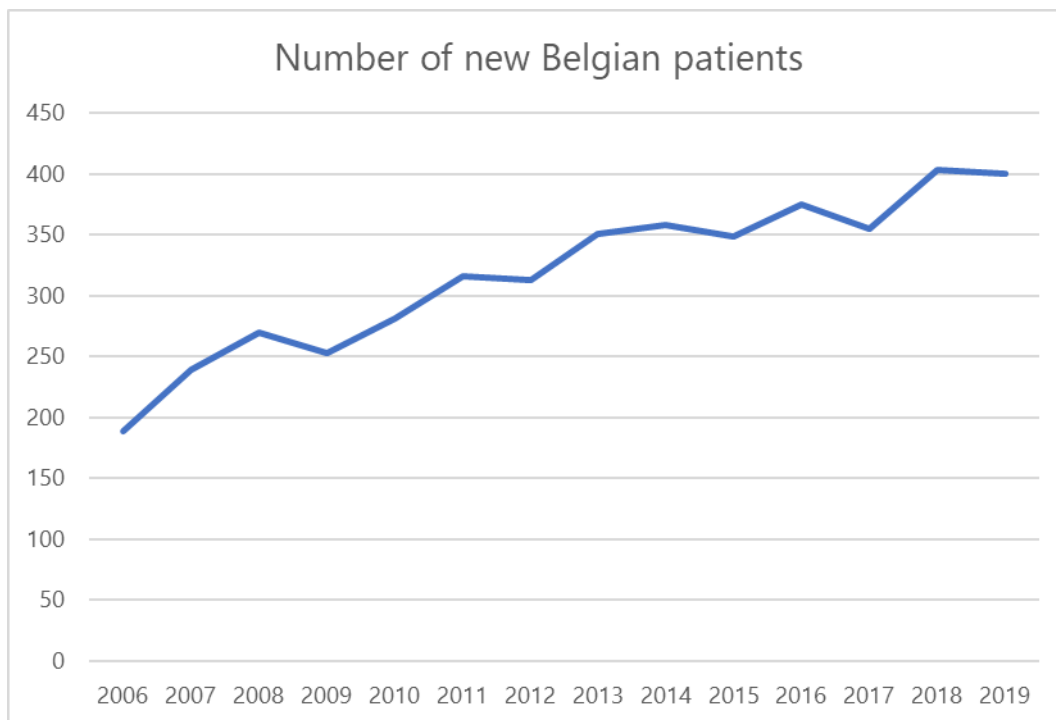

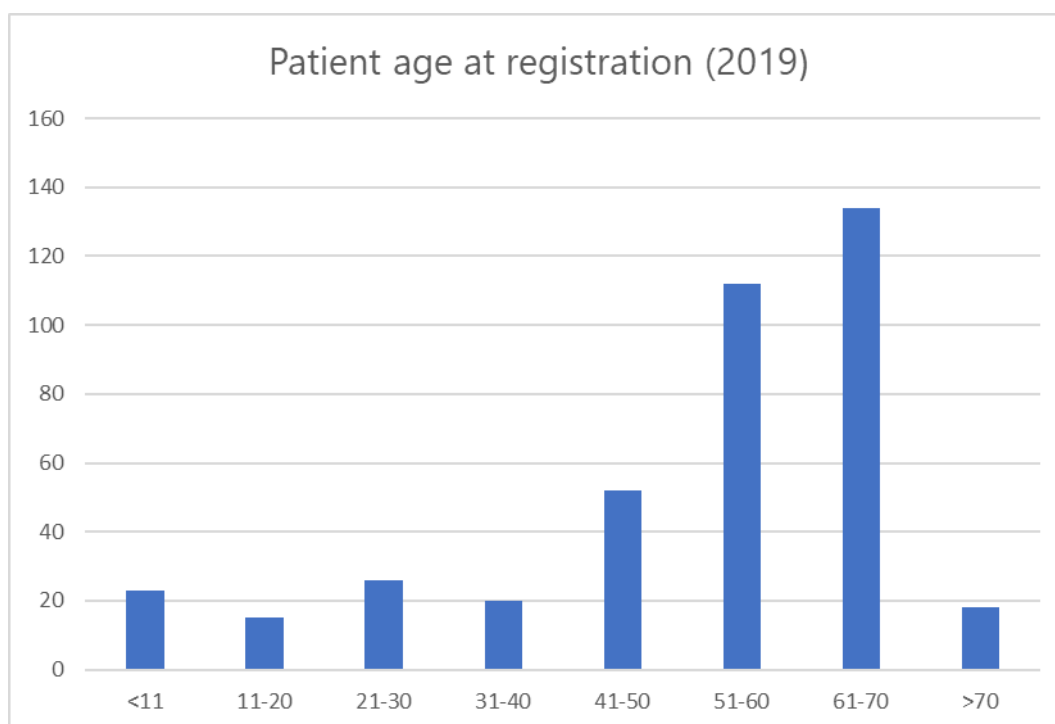

3.2 Patient age at registration in 2019



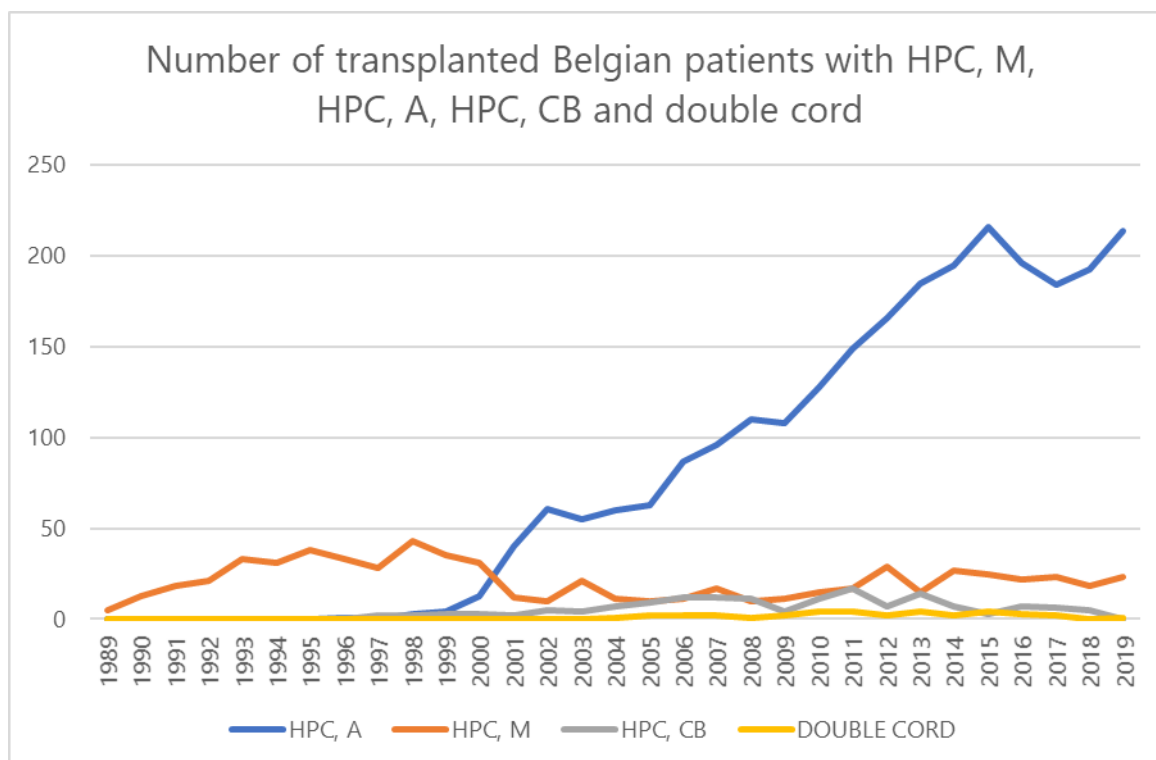

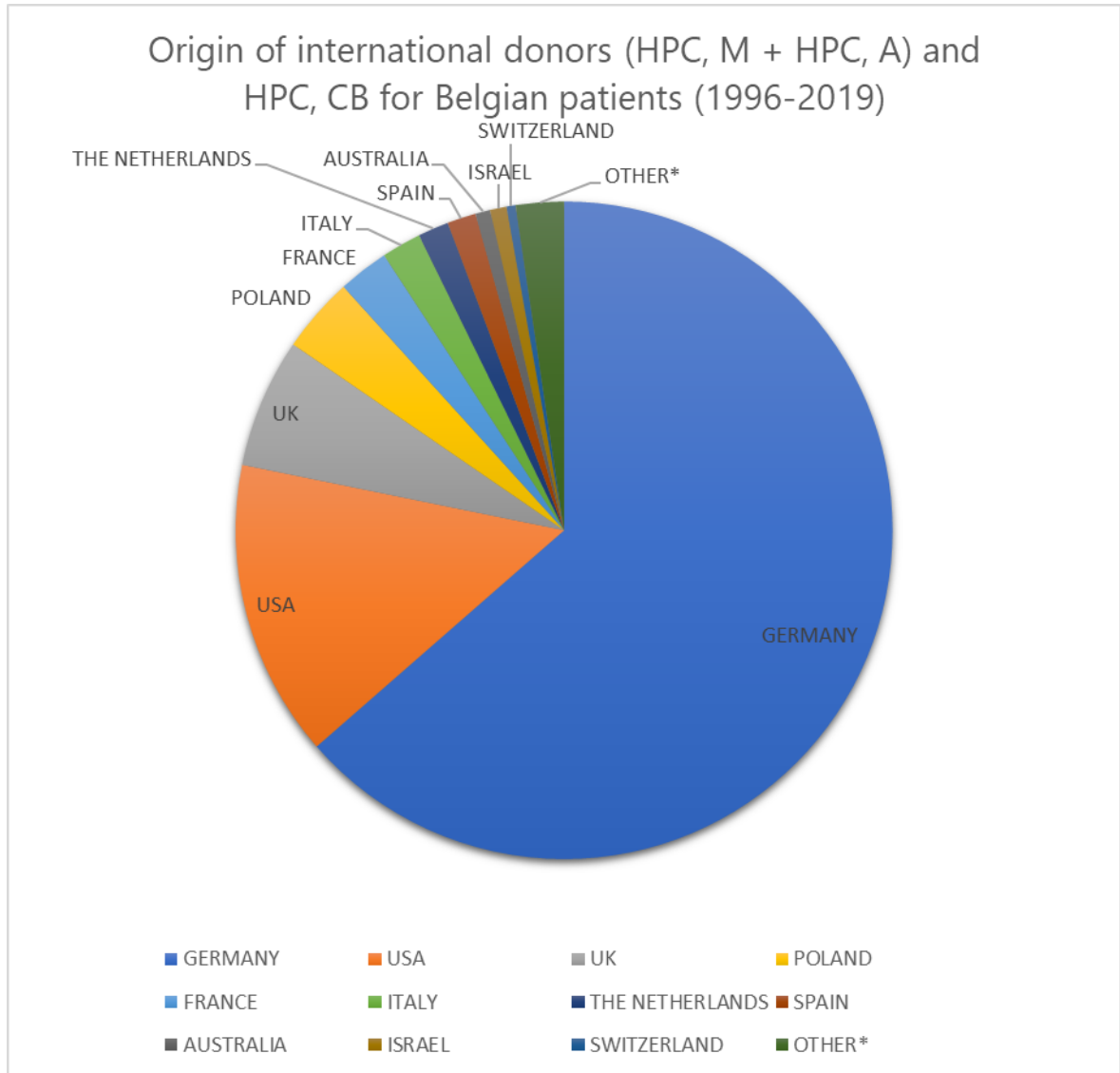

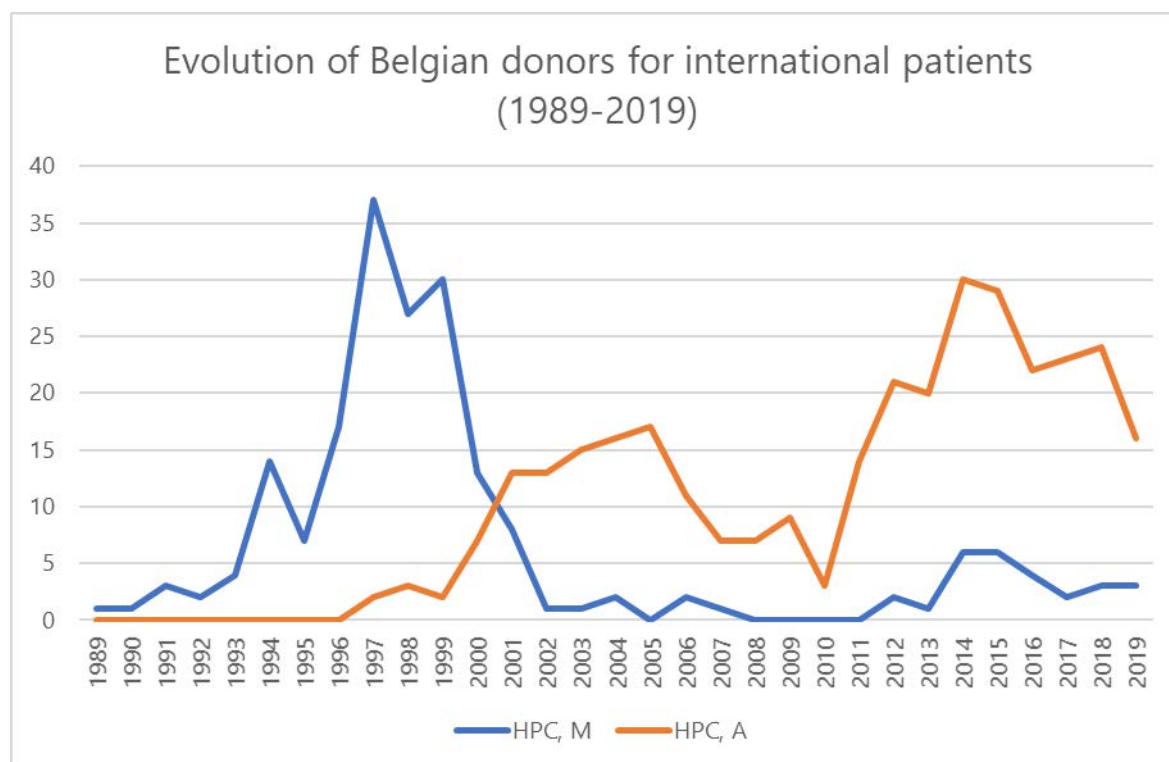

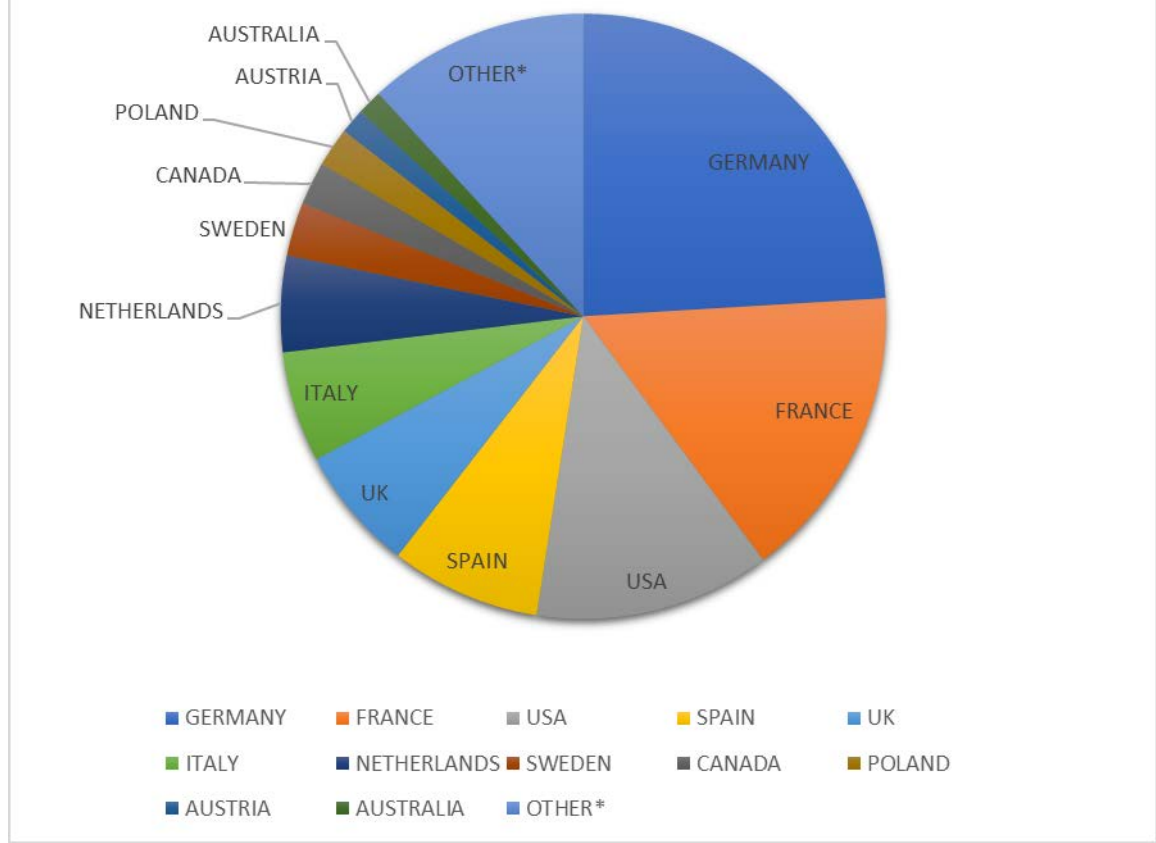

Distribution of harvests of Belgian donors (HPC, M and HPC, A) for international patients (1989-2019)



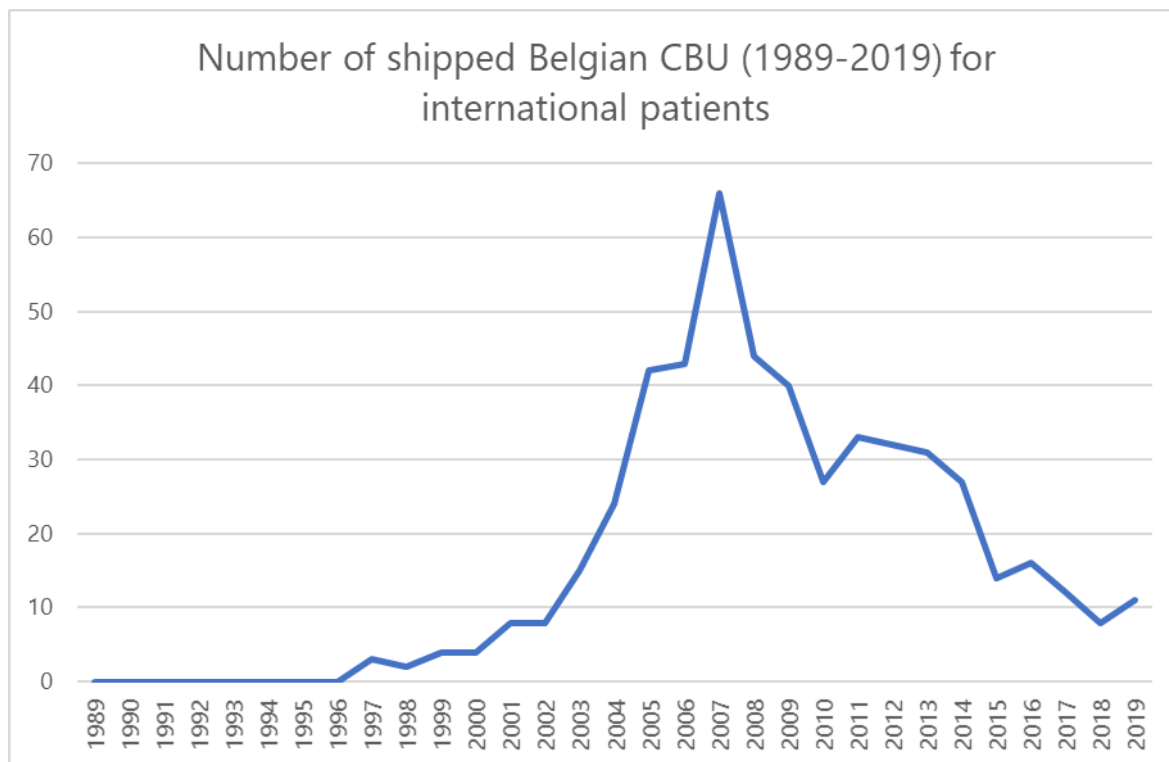

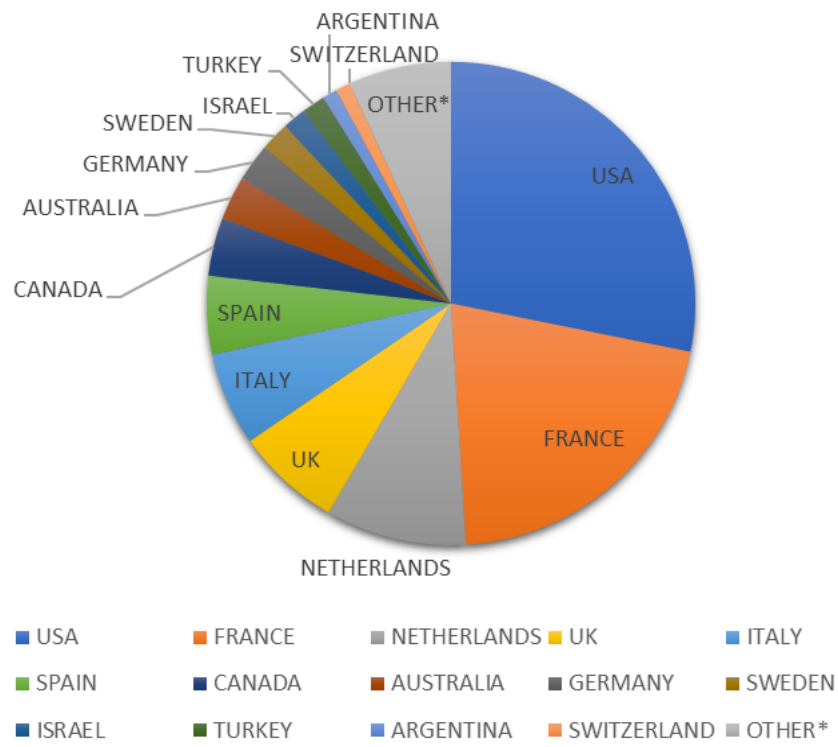
